Talking about pictures: Films

Take some time to look at the photo.

What will you need to mention?

Who? What? Where? When? Why?

Try to describe or talk about the picture by answering some key questions.

1. What's the topic or main idea of the picture?

2. Who are the people? &

What is their relationship to each other?

3. Where are they?

4. What are they doing?

5. What do you think has just happened?

6. What do you think will happen next?

7. How do you think they feel?

8. Can you find any special feature in the photo?

9. What do you think about this film or any of this kind?

10. Finally, close the description. You can include personal opinion.

If you are comparing two pictures, remember to consider some tips.

Don't's:

- Don't focus on just one photo
- Don't talk very fast or very slow
- Don't repeat your favourite phrases all the time
- Don't be silent too much time
- Don't focus only in similarities/differences
- Don't forget about answering the questions/ follow the guidelines provided

Do's:

- say what the general topic is
- talk about both photos (people, objects, background)
- describe briefly both photos: what you see first, then what you can speculate (what's happening, what has just happened, what will happen next, feelings...)
- Point out the main differences
- Add personal opinion or advice
- Complete the tasks provided
